Abstract

- Incorporates all stages of the plastics value chain including design, production, retailing, use, collection, sorting, recycling and recovery;
- Covers all plastic and single use plastic packaging all shapes, all polymers;
- Presents ambitious and timely targets that reflect all stages of circularity, including targets for incorporating recycled content;
- Involves representatives of the value chain of the plastic packaging value chain, public and private entities, non-governmental organizations and associations and academy representatives;
- It is an initiative belonging to the Plastics Pact Network convened by Ellen MacArthur Foundation and WRAP.
